ADMISSION POLICY AND PROCEDURES

Nursery – K4

A student may be admitted to Grace Place Preschool only after established requirements and conditions have been fulfilled. A student or family who does not cooperate or agree with the purpose and program of the school will not be admitted or allowed to remain in the school. Grace Place Preschool requires that all students be the appropriate age on or before September 1st for the class they are applying for. Grace Place Preschool is not equipped to accept students with learning disabilities and/or behavior disorders.

1. **Application:** A completed application, all required paperwork, as well as the \$175.00 *non-refundable* Enrollment fee. **Fee(s) MUST be paid when application is submitted.** Application forms are available in the Preschool office upon request.
2. **Final Acceptance:** Parent(s) and/or legal guardians will be notified as soon as possible regarding the student's acceptance. No acceptance will be finalized until all applicable documentation has been received, and all necessary fees paid in full.

STUDENT DRESS CODE

STATEMENT OF FAITH

Electronic Check Conversion Authorization

Grace Place Preschool has implemented a check conversion service with the following guidelines:

- Only personal, business checks, money orders, and cashier checks written against a U.S. bank account can be converted. No counter checks will be accepted for conversion.
- The paper check MICR line will be captured with a scanner/reader.
- The consumer must be notified that their paper checks will be used to make an electronic conversion. Notification can take the form of a sign posted or a written notice that the consumer is asked to sign.
- The check will be stamped “VOID” after conversion and can be picked up in the Financial Office during normal business hours. If not picked up within three business days, the check will be destroyed.

I authorize Grace Place Preschool to initiate an electronic debit against my bank account whenever I send a check for payment of services. The amount of the debit and bank account information will be used directly from the check. I acknowledge that the origination of ACH transactions from my account must comply with the provisioning of United States Law.

Weekly tuition rate is for childcare August 1, 2022- July 21, 2023, 6:30 am – 6:30pm, Monday through Friday, morning snack, afternoon snack and a daily hot lunch (as applicable). **There is no reduction in tuition for absenteeism, illness, inclement weather, and holidays. See calendar for our Preschool building closings.** In case of inclement weather, announcements will be made on WSB-TV and/or sent via RenWeb Parent Alert. If tuition is not paid by Monday at morning drop-off, the late fee will apply after 12:00 p.m. and the child will not be allowed to return to the center the following week until the balance is paid in full.

Enrollment Fee includes Parent Portal, ACSI Membership, student accident insurance, and activity supplies. K2 – K4 also includes student curriculum and school supplies.

Additional Fees:

- Late Tuition Payment **\$40.00 (Applied tuition is not received by 6:30pm the following Friday)**
- Returned Check **\$40.00 (Each check and after 3 NSF's No checks will be allowed)**
- Late Pick Up Fee **\$25.00 will be charged for any child not picked up by 6:30pm. After 6:45pm, in addition to the \$25.00 charge, there will be a \$1.00 per minute charge for every additional minute thereafter. The money is due when your child is picked up.**
- Early Withdrawal Fee **\$500.00 Early Withdrawal Fee for any student withdrawing after receiving enrollment fee and forms.**

Grace Place Preschool obligates itself to contract teachers and to pay other school expenses based upon student enrollment. Therefore the withdrawal fee is in place if it becomes necessary for a student to withdraw early. Along with the withdrawal fee the parent will be obligated to pay for any tuition up to the date of withdrawal.

Tuition for the 2022-2023 school year will be paid by: (Initial only one of the following tuition options)

➔ _____ **August 1, 2022 – May 26, 2023** (42 weeks/no summer care) --- I agree to pay GCA tuition weekly for 42 weeks even in the event of absenteeism or closings. **(Payment is not due the week of December 26, 2022)**

OR

➔ _____ **August 1, 2022 – July 21, 2023** (52 weeks/includes summer care)--- I agree to pay GCA tuition weekly for 50 weeks even in the event of absenteeism or closings. **(Payment is not due the week of December 26,2022)**

Options of payment are: Check, Cash, Money order, Cashier's check, Auto draft by credit. If you pay using a credit card (American Express, Discover, VISA or MasterCard), fees may apply.

It is the expectation of Grace Place Preschool for every family to maintain a current financial balance. Accounts that are 14 days past due will result in the school administration placing the account on probation. Accounts that are over 14 days past due may result in Grace Place Preschool removing your child from enrollment. We (I) further agree to pay all costs of collection, including costs of a collection agency if the account is turned over to a collection agency and including 15% attorneys fees in the event this balance is turned over to an attorney. It is agreed that this agreement will be governed under the Law of the State of Georgia. Grace Place Preschool has the option of pursuing an action under this agreement in any court of competent jurisdiction in the State of Georgia and we (I) consent to jurisdiction in the State of Georgia. Enrollment of student would be determined by Administration. Parent(s)/guardian(s) of any student who is withdrawn early from school will be required to pay a \$500.00 Early Withdrawal Fee per student. After a student(s) is enrolled to Grace Place Preschool @ GCA, you will be responsible for the \$500.00 Early Withdrawal Fee if you choose for your child/children to not attend Grace Place Preschool @ GCA for the 2022-2023 school year, regardless of when the withdrawal happens.
